Congratulations to the Class of 2024

Amongst the many students celebrating excellent results were: Eleanor De Souza achieving all 11 grades at 7-9 and Callie Tropia with 11 GCSEs including 10 at grades 7-9. Archie Davies and Isaac Haley both achieved 11 GCSEs with 9 at grades 7-9, whilst Adam Stanley, Ravi Frady and Summer Mason each achieved 8 grades 7-9.

Across the full range of subjects, one third of all students achieved at least one top grade 7-9. All students are now planning their next steps which include A Levels at Harrogate and Ripon sixth forms, performance scholarships, high quality apprenticeships and college places in Harrogate, York and Askham Bryan.


