

# <u>Duke of Edinburgh Bronze –</u> 2025/26 – Key Information

## What's involved?

Adventurous, caring, sporty, creative... however you might describe yourself, the DofE is for you. Anyone in the



school year in which you turn 14, to aged 24 can take

part. There are three progressive levels of programmes which when completed lead to a Bronze, Silver or Gold DofE Award.

To achieve your Bronze Award, you'll need to complete your own programme of activities in these four sections (the expedition will be down in school!):



### How long will it take?

Activities for each DofE section take a minimum of one hour per week over a set period of time, so they can be fitted in around your studies and life outside school.

You'll need to participate regularly and show that you're committed to your DofE during this time.

#### **Key Dates**

## The Cost

It will cost £100 to carry out the award (this can be £250+ with other providers!) If your child receives Free School Meals then the cost will be £50.

You will need to pay the school via the Gateway in the following instalments:

•	£35 – 1 <sup>st</sup> March	(£10)
•	£35 – 3 <sup>rd</sup> May	(£10)
